Physical Accessibility

- Wheelchair Access: Our main fishing deck is wheelchair-accessible, ensuring all guests can take part in the fishing experience safely and comfortably.
- Accessible Amenities: We provide accessible bathrooms and pathways throughout the venue.
- **Parking**: Dedicated accessible parking bays are available close to the main entrance for ease of access.
- Seating Areas: Shaded seating is available throughout the venue for guests who
 may require regular rest.

Fishing Experiences

- **Fishing for All**: Guests with mobility challenges can fully participate in fishing from our main deck, with staff on hand to provide additional assistance.
- Hand Feeding Barramundi: While the hand-feeding activity is not accessible for wheelchairs due to pond layout, all guests are welcome to watch and enjoy this interactive experience.
- **Smaller Session Sizes**: To enhance comfort and support, we cap our fishing sessions at 15 people, allowing more personalised assistance and creating a relaxed environment.

Support for Guests with Disabilities

- **Staff Assistance**: Our team is experienced in supporting groups with disabilities and will provide assistance to ensure no one misses out.
- Educational and Sensory Engagement: We adapt educational components of our sessions to suit different needs, offering both hands-on and visual learning opportunities.
- **Community Groups**: We regularly host disability support groups and ensure each guest is included in the experience.

Communication and Information

- Clear Signage: Large, easy-to-read signage is displayed throughout the venue.
- **Pre-Arrival Information**: Guests are encouraged to contact us before visiting to discuss any specific requirements, so we can prepare and provide the best possible service.
- **Visitor Education**: Our team is committed to clear, patient communication, ensuring every guest understands the fishing process and feels included in the fun.
